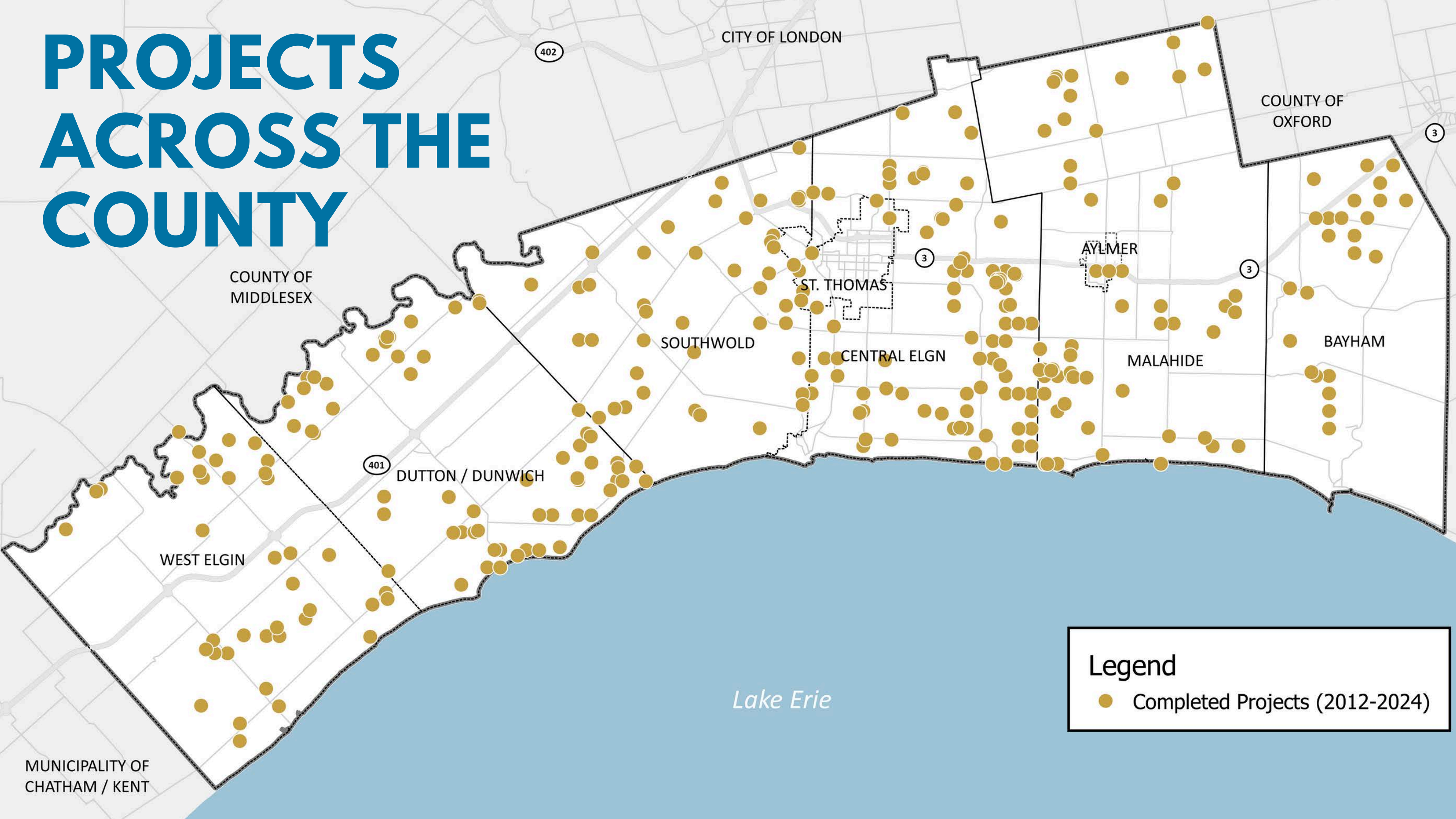

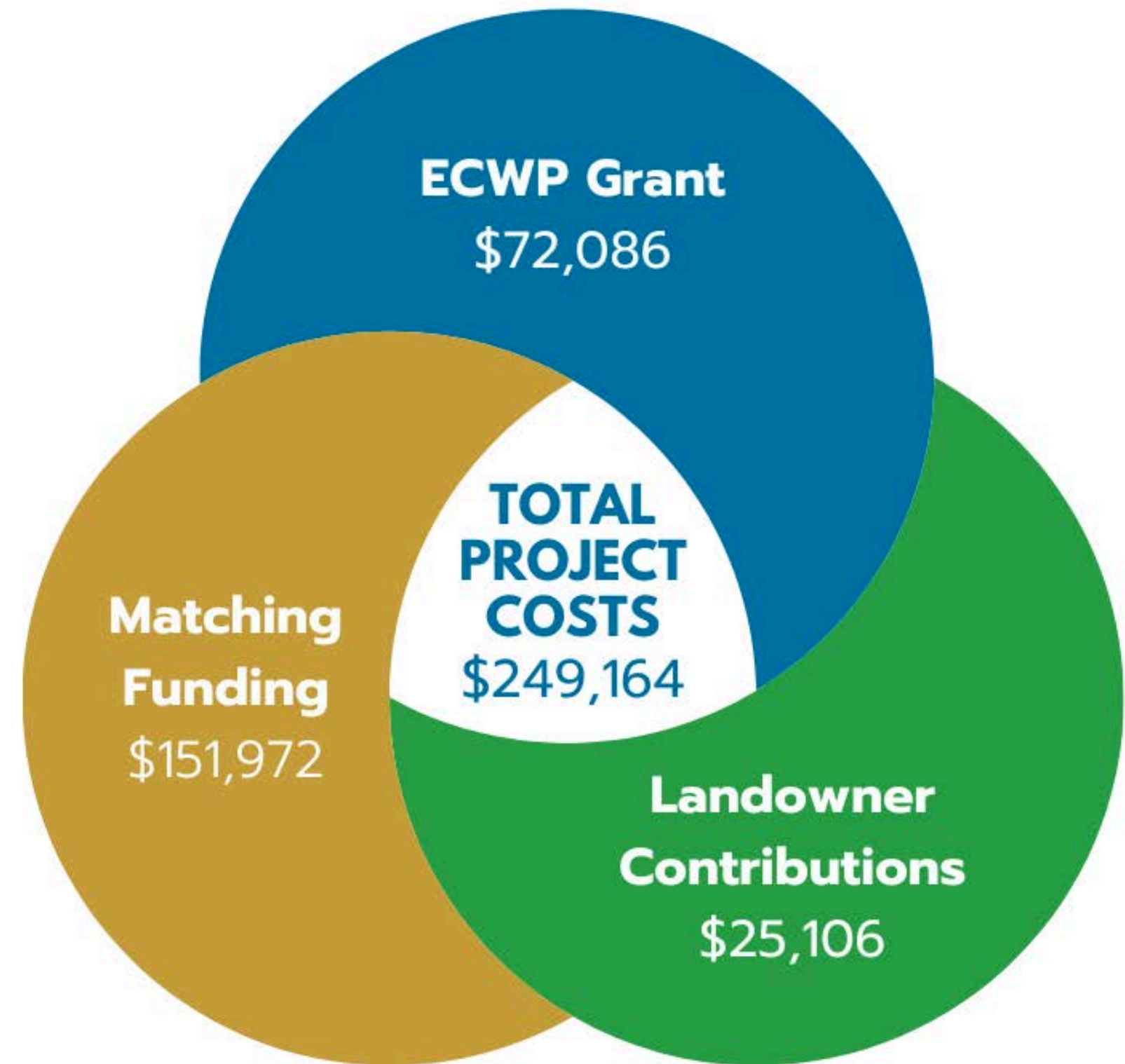

- 4 Cover Crop



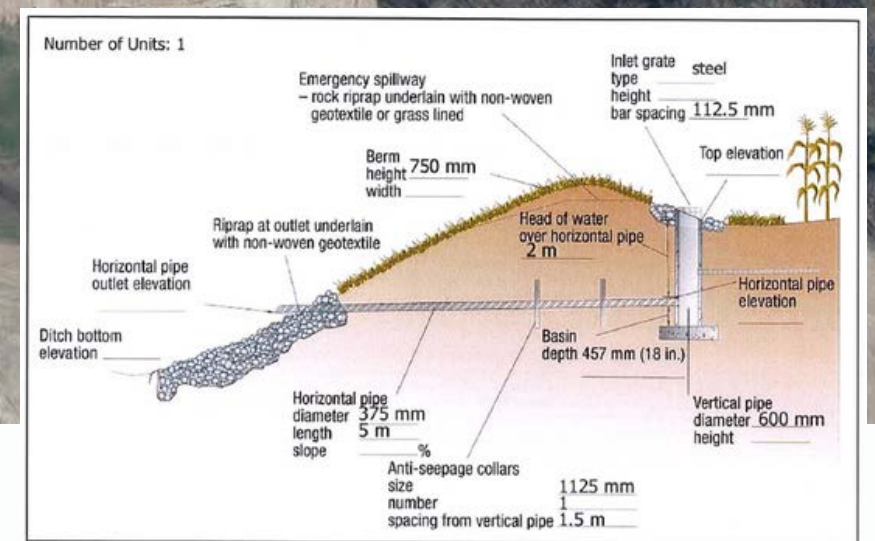
